

Application for New Service

Welcome to North Itasca Electric Cooperative! To make your new service installation easy, we provide individualized help to process and install a new service. To begin processing your new service we will need:

- New Service Information form (included)
- Membership Service Agreement signed (included)
- New Member Account Information form (included)
- Right-of-Way Easement (easements give North Itasca Electric Cooperative permission to install and maintain electrical equipment on your property) with a complete legal description of the property as shown on deed or abstract (copies of tax statements are not acceptable). Right-of-Way Easement must be **signed and notarized**.
- A check for the application fee in the amount of \$106.88 (non-refundable). The application fee is valid for 12 months. If the service is not constructed within 12 months, a new application fee shall apply.

When fees are paid and completed forms are in our office, an appointment will be scheduled with our staking technicians. They will meet you on your property to help determine the best options for your electrical service. After meeting with a staking technician (and before a tentative construction date), you <u>must</u> complete the following requirements before we can proceed:

- Acquire private Right-of-Way easements (private easements give North Itasca Electric Cooperative permission to
 install and maintain electrical equipment on adjoining properties) Right-of-Way Easement must be signed and
 notarized by all affected property owners. (Note: North Itasca Electric Cooperative personnel will apply for
 government easements on your behalf. Any additional fees to be paid by applicant.)
- Clear the right-of-way (20 feet for underground, 40 feet for overhead, 50 feet for three phase service).
- Pay all line construction charges, permit fees, special permits, or lease agreements in addition to specialized equipment required for construction not routinely used by the cooperative. <u>Routine construction charges will be assessed as follows:</u>
 - If there is an existing yard pole, existing transformer pole or existing underground stub pole the cost to install up to a 200A meter loop shall be \$750.00. If there is an existing yard pole, existing transformer pole or existing underground stub pole the cost to install a 320A meter loop shall be \$1000.00. 600A and larger services shall be quoted individually.
 - New construction 0 to 300 feet: \$2700.00, Distances over 300 feet shall be an additional \$6.00 per foot for single phase services. New Construction Three Phase 0 to 300 feet: \$8500.00. Distances over 300 feet shall be an additional \$12.00 per foot for three-phase services.
- Construction season shall run from June 1 through November 1. Quotes not paid in full prior to the end of the construction season shall incur a frost charge of an additional \$10.00 per foot. If there is no frost present during construction, the frost charges shall be refunded.
- Pay deposit if required.
- Provide a required copy of the Minnesota Electrical Inspection form* (MN STATUE 326B.36 SUB DIVISION 5)

*The Minnesota Department of Labor & Industry requires an electrical inspections form be filed. North Itasca Electric Cooperative provides the meter loop or pedestal.

All wiring performed on the consumer side of the meter must be filed with and inspected by the Minnesota State Electrical Inspector per state law. (Forms are available at <u>www.electricity.state.mn.us</u>)

- Agree to comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Cooperative as well as other rules, regulations and policies which may be adopted by North Itasca Electric Cooperative.
- 2) Agree to furnish easement to North Itasca Electric Cooperative for Right-of-Way maintenance, operational procedures, and access to Cooperative equipment.
- 3) Agree to comply with all existing easements on my property from North Itasca Electric Cooperative or its predecessor organizations. I recognize that where the Cooperative has existing facilities on my property that I do grant them permission to maintain their said facilities.
- 4) Agree not to interfere with or endanger the Cooperative's installed electrical system. I agree not to dig, excavate, or grade in areas where underground electric facilities are located without contacting the proper notification center.
- 5) Recognize that North Itasca Electric Cooperative does not guarantee a regular and uninterrupted supply of energy and in case the supply of energy is interrupted or defective, the Cooperative shall not be liable for any damages resulting therefrom.
- 6) Recognize that the quality of such power supply may not be suitable, without modification, for some business and specialized personal uses.

1. Purpose and Extent of Easement: The easement is for erecting, operating, maintaining, repairing, rebuilding and burying overhead and underground electrical distribution lines and related facilities including but not limited to signal lines, poles, wires, cables, handholes, manholes, transformer enclosures, concrete pads, transformers, connection boxes, and such other accessories and appurtenances as may be desirable in connection therewith (the "Facilities") over, under or on the centerline Right-of-Way and all abutting streets, roads and highways. The Right-of-Way is defined as _______ feet on each side of the Facilities existing and to be constructed, but in no event shall it be less than the width on each side of the centerline of the following: (a) 10 feet for underground lines; (b) 20 feet for overhead, single phase primary lines; (c) 10 feet for overhead secondary lines; and (d) 25 feet for overhead primary three phase lines. The easement includes such joint use or occupancy of the easement as North Itasca Electric Cooperative may permit for electrification or other purposes.

2. North Itasca Electric Cooperative's Right of Access: North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right of ingress to and egress from the Right-of-Way over the Owner's adjacent lands and lying between public or private roads and the Right-of-Way, such right to be exercised in such manner as occasions the least practicable damage and inconvenience to Owner.

3. North Itasca Electric Cooperative's Right to Maintain Facilities: North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right to construct new Facilities and extensions of existing Facilities within the Right-of-Way. North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right to inspect, remove, repair, improve and make such changes, alterations, substitutions, and additions to the Facilities as it determines advisable. Owner agrees that all the Facilities remain North Itasca Electric Cooperative's property, removable at its option.

4. North Itasca Electric Cooperative's Duty to Restore: After completing any construction or maintenance of the Facilities, North Itasca Electric Cooperative will restore the Property as nearly to its original condition as may be practical under Code. If underground construction is utilized, North Itasca Electric Cooperative will furnish information showing locations of the Facilities on an "as built" basis.

5. North Itasca Electric's Right to Clear and Maintain the Right-of-Way: North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right to clear and maintain the Right-of-Way, and when necessary, the adjacent lands of Owner, of trees, shrubs, brush, stumps, roots and other obstructions that may endanger the Facilities including the right to cut down all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees that are tall enough to strike any part of the Facilities in falling. North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right to maintain the Right-of-Way to the extent and in the manner that North Itasca Electric Cooperative in its sole discretion determines advisable, including by chemical, mechanical or hand clearing methods. North Itasca Electric Cooperative has the right to correct any violations of National Electric Safety Code (the "Code") requirements caused by construction of any buildings, structures, fences or other obstructions within the Right-of-Way, each at the Owner's expense.

6. Grade Changes and Damage by Owner: If grade changes are made by the Owner, which make it necessary for North Itasca Electric Cooperative to relay or relocate any of the Facilities, the cost of such changes will be paid by the Owner. The Owner is responsible for the cost of any repairs to the Facilities cause by the action of the Owner.

7. Easement to Run with the Land: The Owner reserves unto themselves, their successors and assigns, the full right to take, use, and enjoy the Property in every manner not inconsistent with this easement. This easement shall run with the land and will be binding on the heirs, administrators, successors and assigns of the Owner. The Owner agrees to disclose to their successors in title the existence of this easement. The Owner covenants that they are the owners of the Property and that the Property is free and clear of encumbrances and liens of any character except those held by the following persons:

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North Itasca Electric Cooperative Community Trust



Operation Round Up ® is an ongoing charitable fund raising program to benefit worthwhile community projects. Funds are raised from North Itasca Electric Co-op., Inc. members who voluntarily round up their electric bills to the next highest dollar amount.

Q: How does the program work?

A: Each month, members who wish to participate allow North Itasca Electric Co-op.; Inc. to automatically round up their electric bills to the next highest dollar amount. For example, if your bill is \$68.51, your bill will be rounded up to \$69.00, meaning that month's contribution is 49 cents.

If your bill is \$68.90, your bill will be rounded up to \$69.00, contributing 10 cents.

The extra cents will be put in the North Itasca Electric Cooperative Community Trust. The most any member could contribute annually is \$11.88, but will average about \$6 a year per participant. Individually it doesn't sound like much, but collectively it adds up in a hurry. We average more than \$20,000 in annual giving.

Q: Where and how are the funds distributed?

A: Any organization in the NIECI service area is eligible to apply for a grant from the trust.

Funds will not be used to pay utility bills or go towards political campaigns. Grant application deadlines will be published in the Watts News.

Q: What are some possible uses for the fund?

A: Examples of grants would be funding for fire department equipment, EMS, youth & school programs, arts & education, senior citizen groups and other various community programs and projects.

Q: How will we know where the funds go?

A: A list of the funds awarded will be featured in the *WATTS NEWS* and there will be an annual report for the trust fund. Until the funds are distributed, they will be placed in a trust fund with the North Itasca Electric Cooperative Community Trust.

Q: Who will administer the trust?

A: A nine person volunteer board of directors from the North Itasca Electric Co-op., Inc. service area will review the applications and make grant recommendations.

Q: What is the role of the Operation Round Up ® Trust Board of Directors?

A: Separate from the North Itasca Electric Co-op., Inc. Board of Directors, this non-paid board will oversee the trust, evaluate applications made to the program and make recommendations for issuing grants. They will have a set of bylaws by which to operate.

Q: What if I can't or don't want to participate in this program?

A: We realize that not everyone is willing or able to participate in the program. You may optout of the voluntary program. **However, if you do not notify us of your decision to opt-out, you will automatically be enrolled in the program.** You may opt-out at any time in the future if your situation changes or you may optback-in as well. 


